LOCATION

SEVAGRAM

Sevagram is located 8 kms from Wardha city. Earlier known as ‘Shegaon’, it came to be known as Sevagram, after Gandhiji made his residence here during the freedom struggle. Now it has become Free India’s pilgrimage center. The hut in which Gandhiji lived is known as ‘Bapu Kuti’. In Sevagram, there is a well equipped reputed Medical Institute, the Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences with Kasturba Hospital and in addition to the Kasturba Nursing College there are many other educational institutions such as Kasturba Nursing School and Kasturba Vidya Mandir.

WARDHA

Wardha district is located in the eastern part of Maharashtra. Wardha is the district headquarters. It is also an important railway junction on the Mumbai-Calcutta, Delhi-Chennai rail route. It is also an important city for education having two Medical Colleges, three pharmaceutical colleges and six Engineering Colleges. Inspired by Mahatma Gandhi’s values, a number of institutions have been founded including Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences (MGIMS), Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Vishwavidyalaya, International Institute for Gandhian Studies, Shanti Stupa (Indo-Japanese Temple). Also there is a center for propagating Hindi-the national language-Rashtra Bhasha Prachar Samiti. Dattapur and Manohardham, a self sufficient center for the leprosy patients. The Laxmi Narayan Temple located in Wardha town, is the first temple in the region thrown open to Harijans. Besides this Vinoba Bhave’s Pawns Ashram, Gopuri, Bajaj Wadi, Mahila Ashram, Bal Mandir and Gram Seva Mandir are the other well known institutions in Wardha. A large industrial estate including cotton industry, Food Corporation of India and Government Milk Scheme are located in the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC) area on the way from Wardha to Sevagram.

STAGES OF DEVELOPMENT OF KASTURBA NURSING COLLEGE

In 1938, Late Honorable Dr. Sushila Nayar, Ex. Union Health Minister, Founder President, Kasturba Health Society and Founder Director of Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences was entrusted by Mahatma Gandhi the responsibility to control epidemics of cholera and malaria in and around Sevagram. It was felt that a dispensary was required to help the general patients of the villages and the same was started with a group of untrained workers in the surroundings of Gandhiji's Ashram.

Dr. Sushila Nayar succeeded in preventing the spread of epidemics. When Gandhiji was in prison, Shri. G.D. Birla had arranged for a guest house at Sevagram for the guests of Gandhiji. In 1945 this guest house was handed over to Dr. Sushila Nayar and converted into a small Kasturba hospital, mainly for mothers and their children.

In 1973 Kasturba Nursing School was established by the Kasturba Health Society, Sevagram. General Nursing and Midwifery training course of three and half years duration was started. In the beginning, ten students were admitted every six months and from 1977, 20 students were admitted yearly. Presently the school admits 40 students every year.

The Kasturba Nursing College was started in the year 1997 in a spacious building constructed out of donation given by Urmiladevi Laxmiprasad Poddar. Foundation Stone of this building was laid by Late Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma, who was the Vice President of India in the year 1990 and he himself inaugurated the Nursing College building as the President of India in the year 1993.

The Kasturba Health Society received permission to start the Kasturba Nursing college on "No Grant" basis. Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (2 years degree programme) was started in 1997, with intake capacity of 10 seats. It was affiliated to Nagpur University. Since 1998, this degree course has been affiliated to the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, Maharashtra Nursing Council, Mumbai and Maharashtra University of Health

Sciences, Nashik have given permission to increase the intake capacity from 10 to 20 from the academic year 2007-2008.

Basic B.Sc. Nursing course (40 seats) has been added in 2008-2009.

Post Graduates program (M.Sc. Nursing) Started from the academic year 2011-12 with four clinical specialties – Medical Surgical Nursing, Psychiatric Nursing, Obstetrical & Gynecological Nursing, Community Health Nursing, with an intake of 20 seats.

The College is attached to 972 bedded Kasturba Hospital of Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram. The students get rich experience in theory and in Practical/Clinical.

POST BASIC B.Sc NURSING

PHILOSOPHY

Kasturba Nursing College, Sevagram, affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik subscribes to the University of which it is a part. It also advocates Gandhian philosophy based on principles and philosophy of Kasturba Health Society.

The faculty believes in the development of post Basic B.Sc programme in nursing based on the application of principles of modern health sciences, including research which can help in the improvement of quality of nursing education and practice in India. The philosophy of Post Basic B.Sc Nursing is incorporated by MUHS as part of Indian Nursing Council.

Faculty believes that:

Post Basic B.Sc programme is essential to prepare nurses to improve the quality of nursing education and practice in India. Graduate programme in nursing builds upon and extends competence acquired at the graduate levels, emphasizes application of relevant theories into nursing practice, education, administration and development of research skills. The programme prepares nurses for leadership position in nursing and health fields who can function as nurse specialists, consultants, educators, administrators and researchers in a wide variety of professional settings in meeting the National priorities and the changing needs of the society. The programme encourages accountability and commitment to lifelong learning which fosters improvement of quality care.

AIMS:

The aim of the undergraduate nursing programme at the Post Basic level is to upgrade the diploma (GNM/RGNM) nurses to:

- Assume responsibilities as professional, competent nurses and midwives at basic level in providing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative services.
- Make independent decision in nursing situations, protect the rights of the client and facilitate individuals and groups in pursuit of health, function in the hospital, community nursing services and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice. They are also expected to assume the role of teacher, administrator, supervisor, manager in an educational, clinical/public health setting.

OBJECTIVES:-

On completion of Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing programme the graduates will be able to:

1. Assess the health status, identify nursing needs, plan, implement and evaluate nursing care for patient / clients that contribute to health of individuals, families and communities.
2. Demonstrate competency in techniques of nursing based on concepts and principles from selected areas of nursing, physical, biological and behavioral sciences.
3. Participate as members of health team in the promotive, preventive curative and restorative health care delivery system of the country.
4. Demonstrate skill in communication and interpersonal relationship.
5. Demonstrate leadership qualities and decision-making abilities in various health care situations.
6. Demonstrate skills in teaching to individuals and groups in health care settings.
7. Demonstrate managerial skills in health care settings.
8. Practice ethical values in their personal and professional life.
9. Participate in research activities and utilize research findings in improving nursing practice.
10. Recognize the need for continued learning for their personal and professional development.

ADMISSION

Admission to the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course of Kasturba Nursing College is made according to the rules and regulations framed by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik (MUHS), Indian Nursing Council (INC) and Kasturba Health Society.

These rules are subject to alterations, amendments and modifications as may be considered necessary from time to time as per guidelines from Indian Nursing Council, Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik (MUHS) and Kasturba Health Society.

Criteria for Admission on Merit Basis-

- Aggregate of Marks obtained in GNM/RGNM Course.

RESERVATION

Constitutional : 47% seats are reserved for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/VJ/NT/OBC (including SBC)/SEBC/EWS categories. The candidate claiming the reservation under any of these categories shall produce: **original caste certificate, caste validity certificate and a non-creamy layer certificate** at the time of verification of certificate. **No extra time will be given for the same.**

Please Note:- Constitutional reservation will not be considered unless duly signed and prepared caste certificate, caste validity certificate and a non-creamy layer certificate (where applicable), which is valid up to 31st March 2021 is Presented to the scrutiny committee.

INSTRUCTION FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM

- The application form must be filled by the candidate in her own handwriting. All the particulars should be written by the candidate in his/her own handwriting in CAPITAL /BLOCK letters with **dark blue/black ball pointed pen**.
- Write contact telephone/mobile number in the space provided with STD code. Please note that proper contact phone number must be given for any urgent communication.
- Avoid overwriting, cutting and erasing in the application form. Any error and consequences arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidate.
- Check list : After filling the application form, tick mark the boxes in the check list, after verifying that you have attached the corresponding document/s with the application form.
- The application form complete in all respects can be submitted personally, at the Admission Cell of the Principal's office or can be sent by registered /speed post. Which should reach to the college before the last date of submission of forms.
- Incomplete application form will be rejected
- The cost of prospectus, application form shall not be refunded.

VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATES AND ADMISSION

- Candidates who have taken admission elsewhere should bring the bonafide letter from the Principal of the Institution in which he/she has taken admission mentioning that the original certificates have been retained by that institution. However the candidates must produce the attested photocopies of all original

certificates and on confirmation of admission at Kasturba Nursing College, they have to submit all the originals. No extra time will be provided for the submission of original certificate.

- Original certificates of the candidates will be scrutinized and these along with the attested photocopies will be retained for official purpose.
- Total fees is to be deposited at the time of admission for those who are not eligible for scholarship.
- All admitted candidates **must** join the college with effect from 01st October, 2020.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- 1) Candidate must be an Indian National
- 2) 10+2 / Higher Secondary / Pre Degree Course
- 3) General Nursing and Midwifery- certificate as RNRM obtained from State Council with minimum 55% of marks for open category & 5% relaxation will be given for reserved category.
- 4) The candidate should be medically fit to undergo the professional course. She will have to undergo a medical examination at Kasturba Hospital of MGIMS at the time of admission.
- 5) Age limit for open candidate is 40 yrs and for reserved candidate is 45 yrs on or before 31st October 2020.

The fee structure is fixed by fee fixation committee appointed by Govt. of Maharashtra at the beginning of the course. It is binding on us to follow the same fee structure.

- The hostel and mess fee is decided by the management at from time to time, which is binding on the students.
- University fees will have to be borne by the students, which is fixed from time to time by MUHS.
- (Fees can be paid by Demand Draft in favour of '*Kasturba Nursing College, Sevagram*' – payable at Sevagram, Wardha. Cheque and Cash is not accepted).

Note : If the candidate discontinues the course before completion, she has to deposit the fees for the whole course.

SYLLABUS :- As per guidelines of Indian Nursing Council and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Students are expected to lead simple life, wear khadi clothes and take vegetarian meals, must not smoke or drink alcoholic beverages.
2. Student must participate in community prayer and shramdan.
3. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the College. Also the candidate is liable for punishment according to clause 9.1 of the UGC regulations.
4. Candidate after taking admission have to give an undertaking countersigned by his/her parents that she shall not indulge in any activity which amounts to ragging and if he/she is found guilty he/she shall be punished as per the disciplinary rules.
5. Hostel and mess is available for all outstation students, if required.
6. Continued absence from the classes for over one month without any valid reason will make the student liable to be removed from the College Rolls.
7. As per MUHS, Nashik every student has to attend a minimum of 80% practical and theory classes to be eligible for appearing in University examination. However 100% attendance in clinical area is compulsory before completion of the course.
8. If the students discontinue the training period she/he will have to pay the entire course fee for the remaining period.
9. The student has to follow strictly the curriculum planned by the College.
10. Student will have to shift their rooms according to the availability of accommodation.

RAGGING IS PROHIBITED IN THE INSTITUTION

Ragging includes the following:

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Candidates and parents should be fill undertaking for anti-raging through online on website www.antiragging.in and submitted in college office.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging

- Abetment to ragging;
- Criminal conspiracy to rag;
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- Public nuisance created during ragging;
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- Wrongful restraint;
- Wrongful confinement;
- Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even unnatural offences;
- Extortion;
- Criminal trespass;
- Offences against property;
- Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation.
- All other offences following from the definition of “Ragging”.

AWARDABLE PUNISHMENTS

At the College/Institute level:

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty or ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation Process.
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension /expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- Fine of Rs. 25,000/- to Rs. 1 lakh.
- Collective punishment.
