CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1. Students are expected to lead simple life, wear khadi clothes and take vegetarian meals, must not smoke or drink alcoholic beverages.
2. Student must participate in community prayer and shramdan.
3. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the College.
4. Candidate after taking admission have to give an undertaking countersigned by her parents that she shall not indulge in any activity which amounts to ragging and if she found guilty she shall be punished as per the disciplinary rules.
5. Hostel and mess is compulsory for all students.
6. Fees shall be paid on the date notified by the Principal's office. After the said date, fees will be

acceptable only within a period of one month with a late fee fine as notified.

7. Continued absence from the classes for over one month without any valid reason will make the student liable to be removed from the College Rolls.
8. Minimum of 80% of attendance in theory and practical is necessary for appearing in University examination. However, 100% attendance in practical is compulsory for course completion.
9. The student has to follow strictly the curriculum planned by the College.
10. If the student discontinues the training period she will have to pay the entire course fee for the remaining period.
11. Student will have to shift their rooms according to the availability of accommodation.
12. Students has to follow the hostel rules strictly .If they do not abide the rules they may be removed from the hostel.
13. Student must wear the uniform prescribed by the college for clinical and community posting.

14. Minimum of 50% marks in the internal assessment is compulsory for appearing for university examination.
15. Any change in the students' permanent address or the mailing address must be conveyed to the principal in writing.
16. Cell phone is prohibited in the clinical area and classroom.
17. Student nurses are to make a point of reading the notice board daily.
18. All students must attend study hours from 7.30pm to 9.30pm each evening except Saturdays and Sundays. Night duty students do not need to attend study hours.
19. Students are permitted to watch the television on Saturday and Sunday between 1pm to 9.30pm.
20. Student will be permitted to go for shopping etc. with permission from designated authority. A register is kept in the hostel and student must sign out before going and sign in upon returning.
21. A student will get special leave during the course of their training only if there is a genuine and valid reason. However the student must follow the MUHS

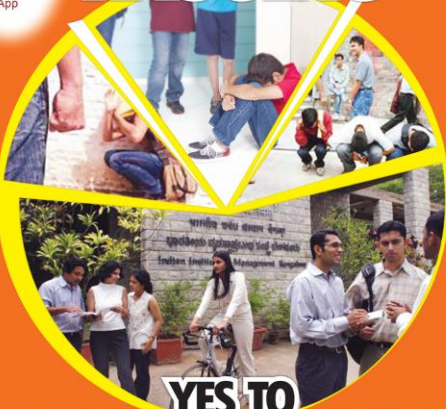

A STUDENT INDULGING IN RAGGING CAN BE:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding/withdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc.
- **Collective punishment** : when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on potential ragger.

RAGGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN OUR CAMPUS

Ragging includes the following:

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of harassing, teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Candidates and parents should be fill undertaking for anti-ragging through online on website www.antiragging.in and submitted in college office.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging

- Abetment to ragging;
- Criminal conspiracy to rag;

- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging;
- Public nuisance created during ragging;
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- Wrongful restraint;
- Wrongful confinement;
- Use of criminal force;
- Assault as well as sexual offences or even or even unnatural offences;
- Extortion;
- Criminal trespass;
- Offences against property;
- Criminal intimidation;
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s);
- Physical or psychological humiliation.
- All other offences following from the definition of “Ragging”.

AWARDABLE PUNISHMENTS

At the College/Institute level:

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty or ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation Process.
- Withholding results
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

- Suspension /expulsion from the hostel
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
- Fine of Rs. 25,000/- and Rs. 1 lakh.
- Collective punishment
