### About Kasturba Health Society

When Mahatma Gandhi started his padayatra (foot march) in 1930 from Sabarmati Ashram to Dandi for the Salt Satyagraha, he had decided not to return to Sabarmati till independence for India was attained. Independence was not attained at that time and Gandhiji was imprisoned for more than two years. On his release he spent sometime travelling. He decided to make a village in Central India his headquarters. He came to Wardha in 1934, at the invitation of Jamnalalji Bajaj. In April 1936, Gandhiji established his residence in the village Shegaon which he renamed as Sevagram, which means 'village of services'. 1938, attracted by Gandhiji's leadership in Indian freedom struggle, a graduate from Delhi's Lady Harding College, Dr. Sushila Nayyar, arrived at Sewagram. In 1944, Sewagram was experiencing a number of epidemics. In this situation, Bapu had decided to convert his guestroom built by Shri. G.D Birla to a dispensary, and later into a 15-bedded hospital for women and children. In 1969, the first rural medical college named Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sewagram was started. Today, it become 972 bedded multi-speciality hospital.

## About Kasturba Nursing College

The Kasturba Nursing College was started in the year 1997 in a spacious building constructed out of donation given by Urmiladevi Laxmiprasad Poddar. In 1997, Post Certificate B.Sc. Nursing course was started with annual intake capacity of 10 candidate which was later changed to Post Basic B.Sc Nursing and the annual intake capacity has been increased to 20 students in 2007. Basic B.Sc. Nursing course was started in the year 2008 with 40 annual intake. In 2011, MSc. Nursing course was started with 4 specialities. At present Kasturba Nursing College is having a total strength of 240 students. The Greatest milestones of Kasturba Nursing College is that, In 2016, Government of India identified us as a 'National Nodal Centre' to conduct 6 weeks training on "Strengthening the Pre-service Nursing and Midwifery Education" in India. In 2020, Government of India identified It as a "National Midwifery Training Institute" and the 1st batch of training was started in July 2022 with 30 candidates from different states.

- Number of slide 08 10 excluding first and last slide.
- Time of presentation 10 minutes (8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion).

- Accepted poster will be communicated by mail on or before 20th December 2023.
- For display of accepted poster, participant should print the poster in banner or flex material in the measurement size 3 into 4 feet (landscape)
